CITY OF INKSTER & CITY OF WESTLAND ANNAPOLIS ROAD RECONSTRUCTION

Project Description

The City of Inkster and City of Westland are joining forces to undertake a pavement reconstruction project along Annapolis Road between Middlebelt Road and Inkster Road. Traffic will be restricted to a single lane eastbound one way, and single lane westbound, depending on phasing, with intermittent stoppages of traffic by flaggers during certain construction activities. The project will be completed in two phases; Phase 1 includes concrete slab replacements and repairs on the South side (City of Westland) and Phase 2 includes the reconstruction of the North side (City of Inkster).

Access

Repair work will be scheduled to maintain a minimum of one driveway open to those properties with multiple driveway entrances. There will be a few individual residences that will have their driveway access temporarily restricted. The contractor will work with those particular residences to find alternate parking while driveway access is restricted.

Tentative Key Construction Dates – these are project and weather dependent

Phase 1 – Start June 4, 2018 – complete June 16, 2018

Phase 2 – Tentative start June 18, 2018 – complete August 31, 2018

Phase 1 South Side of Road Repair (City of Westland)

The eastbound lane will be closed to traffic to perform intermittent concrete removal and replacement. During this phase it is advised for eastbound traffic to travel to Van Born Road to the south or Carlysle Street to the north to bypass construction. Once repairs are complete, and the concrete has cured, eastbound traffic will be open throughout construction.

Phase 2 North Side of Road Repair (City of Inkster)

The westbound lane will be closed to traffic to perform concrete removal and replacement. During this phase it is advised for westbound traffic to travel to Van Born Road to the south or Carlisle Street to the north to bypass construction. Once the repairs are complete, and the concrete has cured, traffic will be restored in both directions.

Project Detours

The phase 2 detour route while Annapolis Rd is reduced to one-way traffic, will be along Inkster Road south to Van Born Road, right at Middlebelt Road. The detour route will not be signed.



Public Services

- Trash Collection – Residents of the City of Westland will have their garbage pick up uninterrupted. During phase II, The City of Inkster encourages their residents to only use garbage bags to be collected by the contractor. This will allow construction to continue without disruption, on trash days.
- Recycling – During construction, recycling will not be collected at each house. A recycling dumpster will be located at the northwest corner of Northland Ave and Annapolis Rd.
- Some Inkster mailboxes may be moved as part of construction. Otherwise, mail service is expected to be uninterrupted throughout construction.

Frequently Asked Questions

- *How will access to homes be maintained?*
During construction access to homes will be maintained. However, at times residents will be required to park elsewhere while the concrete cures.

- *Will trees be removed as part of the construction project?*
Some trees are scheduled to be removed as part of the construction project, and will only be removed as necessary. Trees scheduled for removal will not be replaced.
- *What about lawn restoration?*
Disturbed lawn areas will be fully restored to preconstruction condition with topsoil, fertilizer, seed, and mulch, or sod. If necessary, the contractor will return in Fall 2018 to ensure grass growth.
