Cowan Road Resurfacing

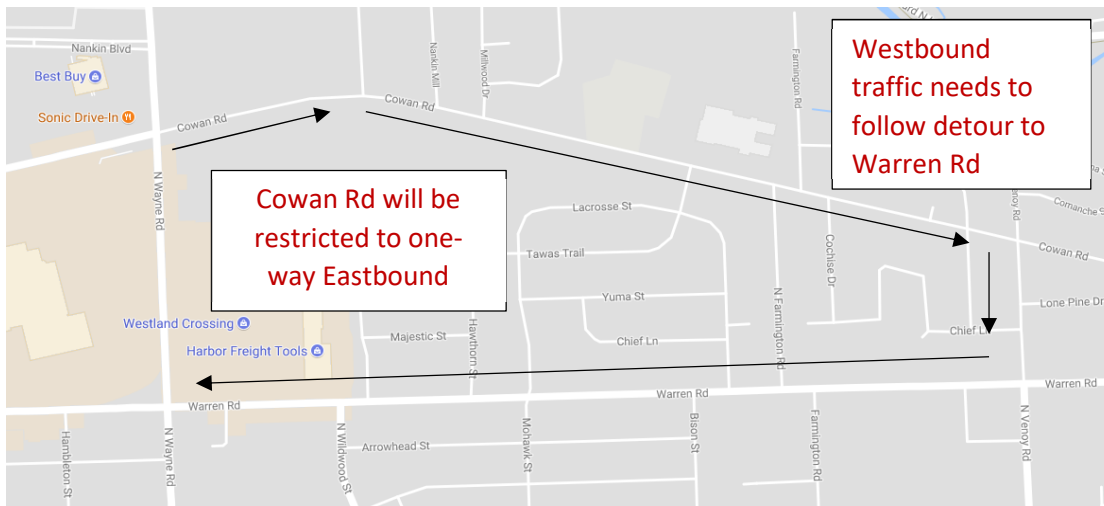
The City of Westland is undertaking a pavement resurfacing project along Cowan Road between Wayne Road and N Farmington Road. The work consists of milling the existing asphalt surface, repairing full depth concrete base slabs and deteriorated joints as needed, and applying new asphalt wearing course.

Road will be accessible to local traffic and emergency vehicles at all times. Access to your driveway will be maintained, except during concrete placement and curing in front of your drive approach for approximately 3 – 5 days. We are kindly requesting that you park your vehicles on the adjacent streets when access to your driveway is not possible. Expect intermittent delays and potential stoppage of traffic during certain construction activities with flaggers.

Mail delivery and garbage pick-up will not be affected during this project.

Traffic Detour Plan

Cowan Road will be open to eastbound, one-way traffic only from Wayne to Farmington for the duration of the construction. The work is tentatively scheduled to **start July 10, 2017 and be completed by August 31, 2017** under normal conditions.
