NOTICE OF MEETING – ELECTION COMMISSION AGENDA May 9, 2022 3:00 p.m.

A meeting of the City of Westland Election Commission will be held on May 9, 2022, at 3:00 p.m. at the Westland City Hall, Council Conference Room, 36300 Warren Road, Westland, Michigan.

The meeting has been called to consider the following items for the State Primary Election to be held on Tuesday, August 2, 2022.

1. Roll Call
2. Approval of minutes for the Election Commission Meeting held on October 4, 2021.
3. Establishment of thirty-nine (39) Absentee Voter Counting Boards, Precincts 1 - 25, 27 – 30, 32 - 41 (Grouped under 943, 944, 945 & 946).
4. Designate location of AV Counting Boards as portions of Westland City Hall.
5. Authorize the City Clerk to schedule the time the AV Counting Board Inspectors will report to work.
6. Approval that the Dominion Voting System will be used for the August 2, 2022, State Primary Election.
7. Authorize the City Clerk to contract with a vendor to prepare test decks and charts to be used for the pre-election logic and accuracy testing for all elections.
8. Authorization of Richard LeBlanc, Shannon Inman, Deanne Richter, Donna DeWinter, Laura O'Callaghan, Iketa White and others designated by the City Clerk to sign the Preparation Certificates and Program Test Certificates and conduct the Accuracy Testing.
9. Approve a temporary change of voting locations for Precincts 1, 13, 18, 19, from Schweitzer Elementary School to Westland Senior Friendship Center for the August 2, 2022, State Primary Election, due to WWCS D building renovation projects.
10. Approve a temporary change of voting locations for Precincts 5, 24, 29 from Edison Elementary School to Stottlemeyer School for the August 2, 2022, State Primary Election, due to WWCS D building renovation projects.
11. Approve a temporary change of voting location for Precinct 33 from Hamilton Elementary School to Adams Middle School for the August 2, 2022, State Primary Election, due to WWCS D building renovation projects.
12. Discuss and approve methods to notify all affected voters of the temporary voting locations.
