Whereas,


We recognize that through awareness and early detection, in the early stages, the survival rate for ovarian cancer is 90% to 95%; and


Whereas,

We recognize it is appropriate to recognize September as Turn the Towns Teal month because during the month of September it is National Ovarian Cancer Awareness Month and it is;


